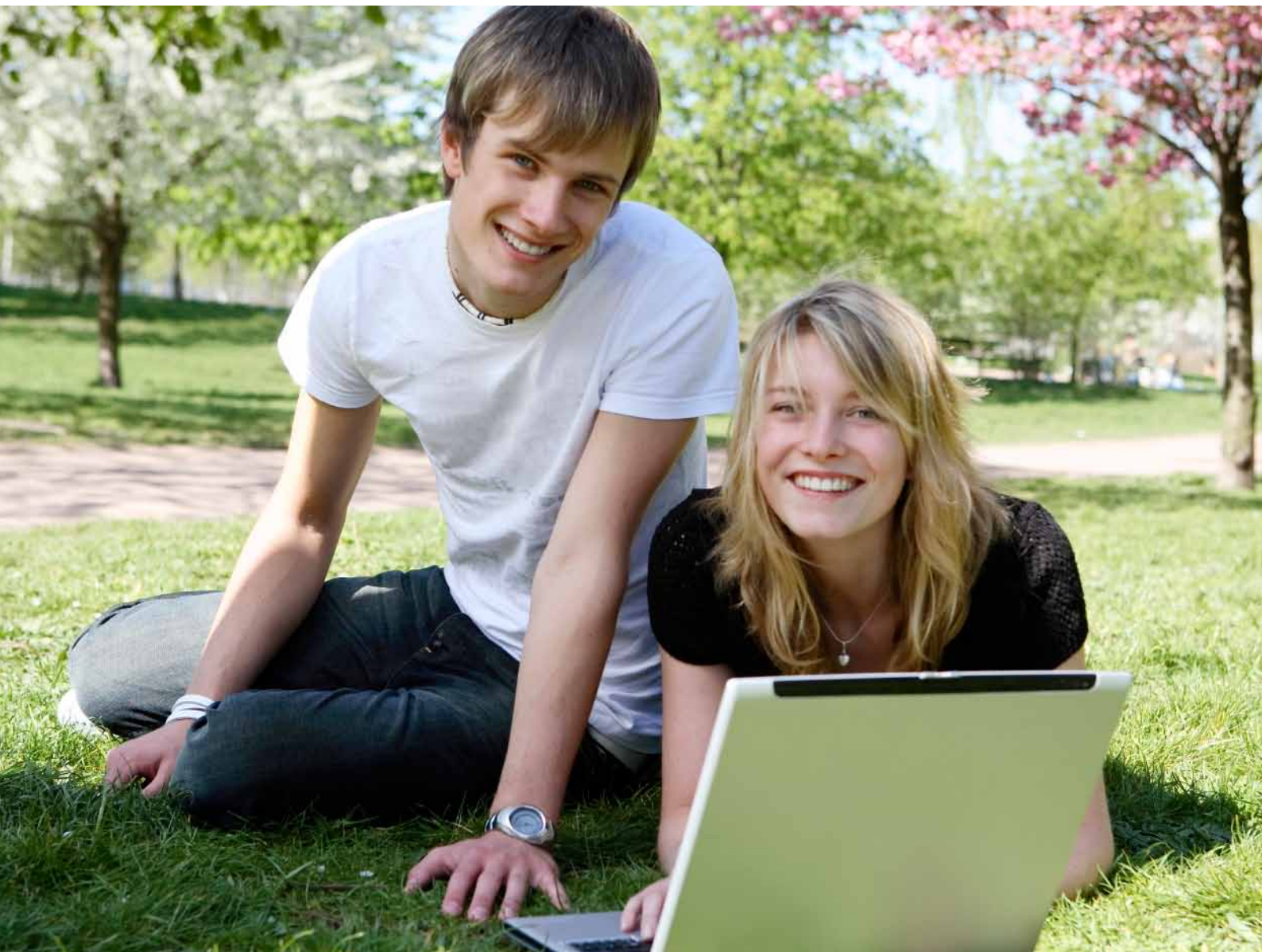


Campbelltown Catholic Club Teacher Education Scholarship Program



what it's all about?

Campbelltown Catholic Club has a proud history of supporting Catholic Education, Sport and Culture in the Macarthur Community. We are passionate about the value of Education. To further these aims and objectives the club is offering five scholarships to students wishing to study Teacher Education at a tertiary level at either Australian Catholic University or The University of Notre Dame. A \$2,000 Scholarship is awarded to assist in meeting costs in the first year of study.

who can apply?

To be eligible for the Teacher Education Scholarship you must be studying in Year 12 for the HSC in 2010 and attend one of the following schools:

- John Therry Catholic High School
- Magdalene Catholic High School
- Mount Carmel Catholic High School
- St Gregory's College
- St Patrick's College

what to do?

Students should express their interest in the scholarship by directing their enquiries to their school. Students will need to fulfil whatever criteria their school seeks to impose in the awarding of the scholarship.

dates to remember

february 2010

Start of Term 1

Students apply for Teacher Education Scholarship through their school.

june 2010

End of Term 2

School advises Campbelltown Catholic Club of their chosen Teacher Education Scholarship recipient

january 2011

Campbelltown Catholic Club will confirm with each scholarship recipient of their success in enrolling in a Teacher Education Degree at Australian Catholic University or The University of Notre Dame

* dates are a guide only

the important stuff

- The Principal of each school will select the recipient of the scholarship
- Campbelltown Catholic Club will take no part in the selection of the scholarship candidate and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the selection
- The scholarship will be a single award of \$2,000 to be awarded in the first year of Teacher Education study at Australian Catholic University or The University of Notre Dame
- The recipients will be awarded the scholarship in two equal instalments of \$1,000 each in the first year of study in their Teacher Education Degree undertaken in 2011. This will occur in semester 1 and semester 2
- The recipient will be invited to receive the second instalment of the scholarship at the Campbelltown Catholic Club's Annual Communion Luncheon held in semester 2
- The School will select the student while he or she is in Year 12 and inform both the student and the family of the award
- The School will inform the Campbelltown Catholic Club School Liaison Director of the name of the recipient by the completion of Term 2 in 2010
- The School Liaison Director will confirm the award recipients with the school by the commencement of Term 1 of 2011

additional info

The Campbelltown Catholic Club employs many young people from the Macarthur Area in casual and part time employment as they pursue their tertiary education. The Club would favourably consider offering such employment to award recipients if they fulfil the appropriate conditions of employment in the Club.

february 2011

Start Semester 1
